Additional Transfer Information

- Individuals must submit a completed Penn College application.
- Students must have gained admission to Penn College and met placement requirements.
- Students must provide an **official** transcript of all college coursework, a Workforce Development Non-Credit Academic Record/Transcript, and proof of current paramedic certification in addition to any other supporting materials required for the major.
- Students must complete a minimum 36 credits at Penn College for coursework prescribed in the final four semesters of the student’s baccalaureate degree profile, a prescribed course sequence for completion of a specific major.
